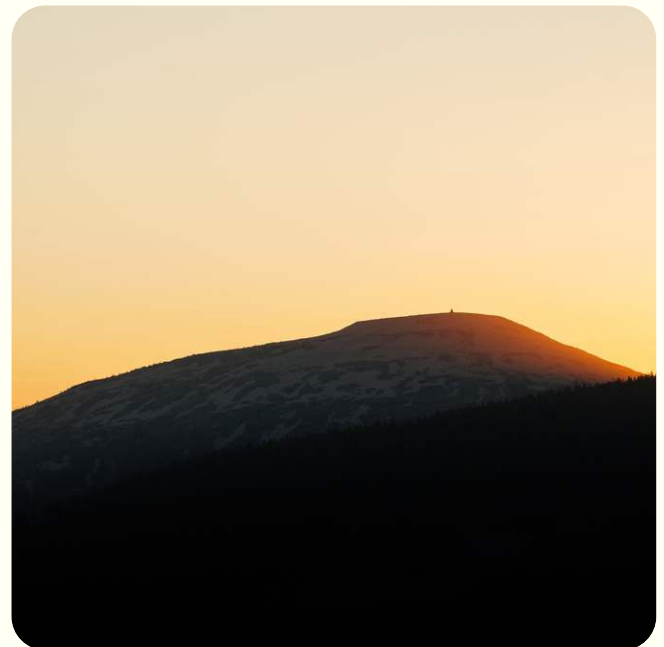
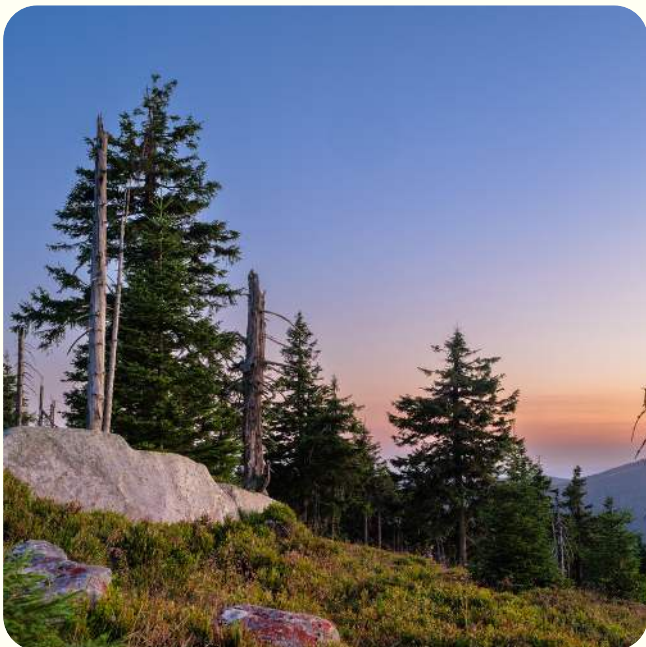


Short intro

Accommodation

For the youth exchange in Spain, you will be accommodated in the hostel ([Albergue Multiaventura Active Andalucía](#)) situated in Almodóvar del Río, and in the Czech Republic, it is the guest house called [Penzion Kozel](#). The venue is situated 3 km uphill from the town of Vrchlabí.



What to bring?

You will need enough comfortable clothes for **indoor and outdoor activities** during the week. For hiking, you will **need good hiking shoes, a backpack, and a bottle**. Also, take all of your daily medication (if you take some) and your **health insurance card**. All materials needed for the program will be provided. If you like to take photos and you have your camera, you can take it too; it can be useful for this project.

Formalities

After the deadline, we will let you know if you have been selected.

If yes, you will be obligated to a learning agreement that commits you to certain rules to create a safe space and a good learning base. We take these rules very seriously. By signing that you consent to the storage of your personal data and to the taking of photographs and video recordings.
